Essex Schools Championships Chelmsford Saturday 14th June 2025

There were 18 podium places for club athletes at Saturday's Essex Schools Championships held in hot but breezy conditions at Chelmsford.

The medal roll started in the first race of the day as Amy Mansell smashed her personal best by almost a second to win gold in the Inter Girls' 300m hurdles for the first of five gold medals for club youngsters.

Findlay McLaren upgraded his Inter Boys' 800m silver from last year to gold this time round and Freddie Rowe comfortably added gold in the Inter 1500m championships.

The other two golds came on the field as club record holder Ayla Baker dominated the Junior girls' javelin and Lila Chapelhow added Inter hammer gold.

There were 13 other podium places, seven silver and six bronze.

Poppy Vines and Orla Friel (PB) both won Inter track silvers in the 1500m and 3000m respectively, while Sam Horsley added Inter boys 3000m silver and recent recruit Denzel Mwasha smashed his PB on the way to junior boys' 200m silver too. Emanuel Iwuchukwu improved his triple jump best for Inter boys silver and another field event silver went to Harrison Rabess in the Inter discus.

Four of the six bronze medals were gained by the Inter boys as Max Adeosun's PB earned a 200m podium place and the other three gongs came in the field thanks to Bode Thompson with a high jump PB, and throwers Sam Johnson, hammer and Sam Burdett, javelin.

Emmie Lole improved her best for Inter 800m bronze as did Grace Tilson with bronze in the 1500m steeplechase.

The Essex County Schools' selectors met on Sunday to select the young athletes in their 70 strong team to contest the prestigious English Schools Championship sat Birmingham on Friday 11th and Saturday 12th July. Those selected will have their place confirmed in the next day or so.
