

## Essex Cross Country Relay Champs Hylands Park Sat 11th October 2025

Havering AC teams started the winter season well by winning two golds and three silver medals at the Essex Cross Country Relays held at Chelmsford's Hylands Park course on Saturday.

The **Under 17 Men** upgraded their silver last time out to gold this year. Sam Horsley gave the team a head start with his 9:28 opener and Findlay McLaren's 9:52 leg maintained the advantage and Freddy Rowe's blistering 9:17 anchor, the fastest of the day, brought the trio home almost a minute in front of the rest. The B team of Shea Sweeney, Sean Mugagga and Aidan Doherty were fourth and the incomplete C team of Ethan Carroll and Liam Battrum also saw action.

The Masters 40 defended their title in style as Ian Anthony got the team off to a good start coming home in fifth place with his 22:39 leg, before James Connor, took over the baton and brought the team home into clear first place with his swift 20:13 leg and Rob Warner extended the lead on the final leg with his 21:34 leg to bring the team home over three minutes clear of their nearest rivals for gold. The M40 B team of Barry Smith, Graham Pritchard and James Blogg all showed a return to form and finished in ninth and were the first M40 B team.

The first of the three silver medals came in the junior girls' race thanks to the **Under 17 Women's** trio of Orla Friel (11:11), Jasmine Asmal (12:19) and Poppy Vines (11:35). The B team of Ruby Price, Ruby Beasley and Grace Tilson were fifth and the C team of Daisy Cossey-Atkins, and Olivia and Holly Bradbury placed 10<sup>th</sup>.

Two more medals were earned in the combined Women's and male masters' event. Solid legs from Ginte Bailey (24:43) and Robyn Matson (25:40) kept the team in the **Senior Women's** medal hunt before Kate O'Neill's brilliant anchor leg of 21: 23, the fastest women's leg of the day, overhauled several teams ahead of her to bring the team home for silver. The U20 Women's trio of Hannah Evans, Rosie Warner and Charlotte were 10<sup>th</sup> in the senior event and the Senior B Team of Clare Davies, Clare Rudgley and team manager Jane Hallam came home in 20<sup>th</sup>. The final silver came from **M60** team of John Barker (24:14), Paul Berrett (27:59), Tony Pecoraro (25:10) who all ran well to finish in second place, under 40 seconds behind winners Colchester Harriers.

The **Senior Men's** A team again had to settle for a fourth place finish. They set off with a strong first leg from by Kieran O'Hara (19:50), handing over in third place and great runs from Chander Dhillon (20:33) and Taylor Newell (20:43) maintained third place. Last leg runner James Stewart (21:04) was unfortunate to be caught by in-form Southend runner Toby Jones with 600 m to go and had to settle for fourth. The B team of Nathan Hart (23:14), Andrew Adebusoye (21:11), Michael O'Callaghan (24:05) and Byron Cipa (23:42) all ran well to finish 19th and were the second B team while Jake Harris was the sole runner in the C team completing his leg in a time of 22.58. A single **M50** team of Steve Walker, Darren Priestley and Roy James finished 9th in their age category.

The **Under 15 Boys** A team of Oliver Rushworth, Jack Forman and Henry Wakeling were fifth, and an impressive three more teams took part with George Burgess, Stephen Hunt and Joe Sewell in 12<sup>th</sup>, Jack Rossington, Thomas Swan and Rhys Cullum 15<sup>th</sup> and Archie Bright, Luke Brewington and Aidan Fairfax in 20th

There was a sixth place finish for the **Under 13 Boys** A team of Harrison Sewell, Joseph Legg and James Fenn and the B and C teams of Alex Stokes, Jack Rushworth and James Campbell, and Toby Clarke, Albie Cossey-Atkins and Harry Jeeves in 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>.

Also in action were the seventh placed **Under 13 Girls** of Molly Jenkinson-Smith, Ava McMillan and Darcy Davies and the **Under 15 Girls** trio of Bethany Friel, Skye Eastman and Millie Cook in 13<sup>th</sup>.
