Although affected by holiday absences and injuries, the Under 13 and Under 15 Youth Development League squad completed their four-match season with an excellent third-place finish at Tonbridge on Saturday. The result confirmed that they will place third in the table, and enjoy another year in the Southern Premier Division in 2023.

The **Under 15 Boys** were in fine form with seven victories against strong opposition. Joel Ajayi's late surge took him to victory in the 200m while Kamel Adjei was second in the B race and was also 100m runner up in a new PB. Findlay McLaren was just outside his career best in winning the 800m, and Jack West was 1500m runner up in a PB, as Sean Langan's PB won him the 1500m B string. Simeon Barker improved his best in winning the B hurdles, as Jack Hignett was third in the A on his club debut and Jack combined with Ryan Alexander in taking full points in the high jump. Sam Burdett won the B javelin, and there were second place points for the hammer pair of Oliver Pullen and Taylor Dixon and William Tilson (B discus). Oliver and Kamel were both third in the shot, as was Jack West in the discus. Ryan, Jack Hignett, Joel and Kamel ran their fastest time of the summer in placing second in the sprint relay.

Sophia Willson was the only winner for the **Under 15 Girls** with her high jump victory but her team mates notched up a glut of second or third places. Leila Jones improved her PB in second in the 200m and was also 300m runner up, while Amy Mansell was second in both the B 300m and the hurdles. Oma Nwapa was second in the A hurdles and B high jump, and Eboni Roach and Grace Tilson were both second in the hammer A & B strings. Third place points on the track were earned by Daisy Leech (800m in a new PB), the 1500m pair of Rosie Warner & Abi Rogers (PB), and Christine Atumonyogo (100m B). Scarlett Woods was third in both the pole vault (PB) and javelin, and Eboni Roach and Charlotte Casey-Sweeney placed third in both shot & discus. Daisy, Charlotte, Rosie and Amy formed the second placed 4x300m relay quartet and Christine and Leila were joined by Laine Forrester-Smith and Mya Thomas in the third placed sprint relay.

The **Under 13 Boys'** team had four winners, with Jacob Tomlinson winning the A string shot, as Harrison Rabess won the B shot, and Jayden Wilkinson (B javelin) and Emmanuel Olubukola-Sogbetun (150m B) also took full points. Sean Mugagga (800m) and Henry Langford (hurdles) were both second, and Emmanuel was third in the long jump B.

Summer Smith won the **Under 13 Girls** 1200m from the front, and was just outside her PB, and Jasmine Asmal's big javelin PB took the javelin honours in this age group. Bel Drake was second in the high jump and third in the long jump, while Bella Taylor-Bush was runner up in both B high jump and 1200m. Kara Adegite set new PBs in placing third in both the 75m and 150m to move up the club all-time lists, and Daisy Cossey-Atkins was third in the hurdles in a new PB.

Reading's win on the day was not enough to prevent Blackheath & Bromley from winning the divisional title, and both teams will contest the national final in September against the other Regional leaders. Havering edged out Tonbridge for third, with both staying in the Premier Division next summer, as Crawley and Bracknell drop into Southern Division 1 for 2023.
