Havering's Youth Development League squad shrugged off athlete holiday absences to end the season unbeaten with their fourth successive win in their fixture at Sutcliffe Park, Eltham on Saturday, to confirm their Southern Division 1A title.

The **Under 16 Boys** showed their overall strength in depth with 13 victories and eight runners up spots. 1 wins of their 16 wins coming in the B string events. Josh Buxton had a hat trick of wins in 100m sprint, the sprint hurdles and long jump, and Rehan Syed won both hurdles B strings. Nathan Hathaway won the B 300m with a PB, added a 300m hurdles PB, edged into second, and made it a third PB as high jump runner up, as Kai Richardson won the high jump B with a career best. There were full points with A & B wins for 800m pair of Jack Rossington and Oliver Rushworth, and the 1500m duo of Freddie Scorey-Hall and Callum Millard Jennings, and B string field wins for Oba Samuel (long jump) and Zephaniah Smith (shot PB). Second places went to David Ojo Ekhaton (100m B), Ethan Johnson (javelin) and Ameer Salaam (shot) and both relay squads - Josh, David, Kai and Zephaniah (4x100m) and Aidan Fairfax, Rehan, Jack and Nathan (4x300m).

Millie Cook once again won both the 300m and 800m for the **Under 16 Girls** team and Ava Sweeney also won two events, the B 300m and B javelin, as Ayla Baker returned to winning ways in the A javelin, and added second place in the A shot, with Danielle Adeyinka was second in the shot B. Nailah Enobakhare won the B long jump in a PB, and Brooke Lavey won the B 300m hurdles, and was second in the B sprint hurdles and long jump while Abigail Adegite had a trio of second places in the sprint hurdles, 300m hurdles and long jump (PB). More second place points came from Keira Senior (100m B - PB), Lucy Jenkinson-Smith (1500m B), and Esther Olajide (high jump). Abigail, Esther, Ava and Millie rounded off the day with a win in the 4x300m relay.

The **Under 14 Boys** had seven wins with Gideon Lee recorded two of them in the A long jump and javelin, both in PBs and placing second in the 200m with another PB, and Teddy Madlin added two more wins in the B hurdles and long jump. Austin Broadhurst and Max Forman (PB) scored full points with wins in both A & B 800m and second places were earned by George Olubukola-Sogbetun (200m) and Kamron Awoyemi-Hall (B high jump). Austin, Kamron, George and Gideon combined to win the sprint relay.

There were ten wins for the **Under 14 Girls** in a dominant victory. Olivia Rae Vaughan won both 100m and 200m, both in PBs and also improved her long jump best in second. Isobel Milton won the hurdles in a PB and also the B long jump, as Isla Herrera won A high jump and the B hurdles, and Destiny Carbon also had a win double in the B high jump and shot. Emily Johnson (javelin) and Moly Jenkinson -Smith (1500m B) also won, with Darcy Davies second in the 1500m A string, as was Violet Everett in the 800m, and Charlen Bangne in the 200m B, and Betsy Morrow in the shot. The sprint relay team of Betsy, Chalene, Destiny and Olivia Rae placed second.

Havering are awaiting other results to confirm whether or not they are one of the two highest scoring teams out of the six Division winners who will win promotion to the Southern Premier Division.
