## Essex Schools Championships Chelmsford Saturday 11th June 2022

# Club athletes bagged over 20 podium places at Saturday's Essex Schools Championships, held in sweltering conditions at Thurrock.

Freddie Rowe once again claimed the headlines. Just a week after improving the club U15 3000m record in lifting the Southern title, Freddie bettered his own club 1500m record in winning the junior boys' title. His winning time of 4m 6.94s took two seconds off the championship best performance which had stood for 40 years. Another championship best fell to Findlay McLaren who won the junior boys' 800m crown with a PB of 2m 00.99s, the second fastest time ever by a club U15. Both will be heading to Birmingham as part of the Essex Schools team competing at the English Schools Championships on 30<sup>th</sup> June/1<sup>st</sup> July.

The Williams brothers will also both be competing at the Birmingham event after both won gold in their respective javelin competitions. Intermediate winner Bobby will hope to improve on his English Schools' bronze medal from last year, while it will be the first English Schools appearance for county Junior javelin winner Zak.

Sprinter Joel Ajayi's breakthrough season saw him set a new PB and gain the judges verdict after a photo-finish confirmed that he won the Inter 100m, sharing the same time as the runner up. Joel's 10.94s clocking was the third fastest ever by a club Under 17. Al-Ameen Salaam won gold in the 100m hurdles in a season's best.

Track podium places were gained by Cassie Campbell, who was edged into silver in the Inter 200m, Tobias Samuel whose PB won Junior 200m bronze and took him into the all-time U15 club top 10. There were sprint bronze medals for Fisola Fagbadegun (Junior 100m), Amy Mansell (Junior 300m), Izzy Pickard (Inter 300m PB) and Maggie Smith won Inter 80m hurdles bronze.

Ruby Tillson's Inter Girls' high jump victory confirmed her English Schools selection and she will travel to Birmingham among the medal contenders. A high jump silver came from Rashaun Mullings-Smith while Faith Wicks won Inter pole vault gold and Scarlett Woods improved her pole vault best for junior silver.

Jessica Page won Junior javelin gold in a new PB, Michael Tesi's PB won him Inter discus silver, Tilly Bunn's hammer PB won her Inter bronze and there were field junior bronzes for Sam Burdett (javelin) and Dillon Humphrey (discus).
