The Southern Athletic League team edged into fourth place in their third-round Division 1 fixture held in hot conditions at Medway Park, Gillingham on Sunday.

The team once again combined youth and experience and returned home with some good results and several personal bests. Orla Friel won the 1500m with fellow Under 17 Ruby Beasley fourth in the B and Emmie Lole's PB earned her 800m runners up spot and Poppy Vines also improved her best to win the 800m B. Another U17 Jamine Asmal tackled the tough 400m hurdles for the first time and won the B race and was third in the triple jump and Claire Brennan was second in both the 400m hurdles A and sprint hurdles B and third in the vault, while Chloe Williams won the A sprint hurdles and was third in the 100m. Team manager Ginte Bailey led by example winning the steeplechase B event as Morgan Campbell was third in both the 'chase A and also the 3000m.

There were good points in the field as Eboni Roach, another Under 17, won both shot A and discus B while Katie Ennis won the A discus, placed second in the javelin, and was third in the hammer. Second places were achieved by U17 Liberty Jamlick, with a PB in the B long jump and Lucy Chapelhow with her B high jump PB, with Amy Mansell equalling her high jump PB for third in the A string and Cassie Campbell placed third in the B 200m.

The men's team found points harder to come by but 400m specialist Matthew Agnimel stepped down to win the 100m in a new career best and also took full points in the 200m. Shane Hart's 400m PB placed him second as did Charlie Burgess's PB in the B 800m as Shea Sweeney set a new PB in the 800m A. James Stewart was second in the longest event, the 5000m and there were 1500m third places for the painting of Andrew Adebusoye and Rob Trevor. Ryan Alexander equalled his high jump PB as runner up and Luke Williams won the vault, with Mark Bishop second in the B, while his on Toby Bishop was third in the javelin

The four-match season ends next month as the squad travel to Norwich and will need to field a stronger team as they face the hosts, as well as Harrow, Chelmsford, London Heathside, and Ipswich/Colchester, all of whom are in the top half of the table.
