

Essex Cross Country League – Rd 3 – Hadleigh Country Park Sat 22nd Nov

Havering athletes recorded their best set of league results of the winter as Round 3 of the Essex Cross Country League took place at a brutally tough Hadleigh Country Park which athletes said was even more challenging than the famous Parliament Hill course. The club highlights saw individual victories for Findlay McLaren and Lauren Reed who led the senior women team to their first win this season.

After finishing runner up last time out Lauren Reed went one better on the hilly Hadleigh terrain to win the **Senior Women's** race ahead of Basildon's Rachel Wiseman. Morgan Campbell's ninth place was her highest finish this season, with Ginte Bailey and Robyn Matson's 14th and 15th places ensuring team success, to join Chelmsford at the top of the table. Under 20s Hannah and Charlotte Evans in their first runs this winter were 24th and 31st, with Clare Davies 32nd while Under 20s Rosie Warner and Abi Swan were 43rd and 57th. Rebecca O'Rourke in 87th, Clare Rudgley 91st and Jane Hallam in 118th completed the 12 strong line up.

Findlay McLaren's fine winter season continued as he won the **Under 17 Men's** race ahead of Chelmsford's Jacob Parrott. Shea Sweeney was ninth and Aidan Doherty 12th as the team had to concede victory to Chelmsford but still head the table. Sean Mugagga was 13th with Liam Battrum 18th and Ethan Carroll in 20th.

The **Senior Men** had their best result so far with all six scorers in the top 20 and a second place finish behind league leaders Southend. James Stewart found the conditions suited him as he placed sixth with Kieran O'Hara one place back and Chander Dhillon in ninth. Taylor Newell in 13th, Rob Warner in 19th and Sam Atkins just behind him in 20th completed the scorers. Andrew Adebusoye was next home in in 28th with Alfie Waithaka 59th and Graham Pritchard 65th. Luke Chester (75th), Will Kirk (83rd), James Blogg (86th) and Under 20 Harry Wyatt (91st) all made the top 100 with Tony Pecoraro 114th, and Steve Rand, Steve Walker, Roy James and Paul Berrett the other finishers. The **veterans**' team of Rob Warner, Alfie Waithaka, Graham Pritchard and Will Kirk were third.

The **Under 17 Women's** team returned to league action to place second. Poppy Vines and Ruby Beasley were fourth and fifth and 19th placed Grace Tilson completed the scoring trio.

The **Under 13 Girls** had their best result so far in second place with Violet Everett in seventh, and Lucy Tregidgo (13th), Molly Jenkinson-Smith (16th) and 21st placed Esther Oyemike the other scorers. Emilia Curley, Eleanor Fair and Isla Herrera finished between 22nd and 25th

There was an even bigger turnout for the **Under 15 Boys** with 15 in action as the team placed third. Jake Tregidgo led them home in 12th with Joe Sewell 17th, and Oliver Rushworth (21st) and Jack Rossington (24th) the scorers as the team were third. Stephen Hunt, Henry Wakeling and Callum Millard Jennings were in the top 30, Cameron Smith & Cruz Carvell were 36th & 37th, with Luke Brewington, Thomas Swan, George Burgess, Archie Bright, Aidan Fairfax, Rhys Cullum and Kieron Devshi also competing.

The **Under 13 Boys'** team again placed fourth with James Fenn 13th and Harrison Sewell in 17th with Joseph Legg (21st) and Parker Swaisland (23rd) the scoring four, while James Campbell and Jack Rushworth placed 34th and 45th.

Millie Cook was first home for the **Under 15 Girls** in 18th, with Alex Field and Olivia Wheeler 30th and 31st and Evie Green 35th as the team were fifth.

Three club athletes made the trip to Sefton Park, Liverpool for the UKA Cross Challenge, which also incorporated the UK Trials for next month's European Cross Country Championships.

Freddie Rowe was 21st of the 200 finishers in the **Under 20 Men's** 4.4km trial event, while Sam Horsley was a respectable 30th of the 180 **Under 17 Men's** finishers. In the **Senior Women's** 8km trial race Kate O'Neill was 18th of over 500 finishers, two places higher than her 20th place finish last year.
