The new National Athletics League, which replaces the former men's British Athletics League and the UK Women's League, finally got under way 12 month later than planned as the club hosted its season opener with a good victory at Chelmsford on Sunday.

Both teams were a blend of youth and experience. Seasoned campaigners Rob Warner and Jason Lendon notched up full points in the 'chase, and veteran thrower Graham Holder took full points in the hammer, while there were victories for the Under 20s as Peter Brinton-Quinn and Bradley James won both javelin strings, Toby Bishop won the B high jump after making his senior 400m hurdles debut, and Reece Harriott impressed with 800m victory, as U20 Luke Chester was second in the B. For the seniors Richard Akinyebo set career marks in both sprints, winning the 200m B, and placing second in the 100m. Ayo Akingbehin (100m) and Michael Shonibare (200m) were runners up in their races, as was Karl Tucker in the sprint hurdles. Ben Davis blasted away for 1500m victory, with John Whitehead second in the B, and Shandell Taylor made it a win double in both the high jump and long jump. Mark Bishop dusted down his kit to score in the discus, shot and long jump

Shandell, Ayo, Akeem Akintokun and Richard dominated the sprint relay for victory, as did Matthew Agnimel, Akeem, Michael and Reece in winning the 4 x 400m event.

Over half the women's team were under 20s, as nine teenagers, most making their senior club debut at this level joined their more experienced colleagues. Under 20 throwers Alice Brown (discus) and Adelaide Thatcher-Gray (javelin) were comfortable winners with fellow U20s Jade Kavanagh and Anne-Prisca Djondo took runners up spots in the A400m & B shot.

Higher Competition Athlete Katy Sealy had a busy afternoon as the Belize heptathlete won the high jump and B javelin and added points in the hurdles, shot & long jump. International Lauren Deadman marked her return from maternity leave with victory in the 300m and runners up spot in the 1500m, as her partners Ginte Bailey (1500m) and Robyn Matson (3000m) also tasted string success. Another athlete returning from a maternity break was Flic Clarke who easily won the 400m hurdles and was second in the sprint hurdles, as club President Claire Brennan set a new club W40 best in winning the 400m hurdles B string, also adding pole vault runners up spot. Ellie Watson won the B high jump to add to her long and triple jump placings. Under 20 Rebecca O'Rourke's 800m PB earned her B string second place, as did Nina Brennan's B string discus effort.

The squad finished the day in style as the 4x400m quartet of Sydney Foley, Nina Brennan, Flic Clarke and Jade Kavanagh led from start to finish for victory.

Round 2 takes the team to Kingston on Saturday 3rd July where the club will hope to match their first round success.
