A strong Havering team got their Southern Athletic League campaign off to a winning start with a big victory at Dartford on Saturday, recording 32 wins and finishing 80 points clear of the opposition, with a club record to cap a successful day.

The club record came from Freddie Rowe, on his league debut as he improved his Under 17 men's 1500m best, which he set indoors this winter when winning national bronze. His time of 4m 00.2s took a second off his best but he lost out on the day to Ilford's Southern senior medallist Alex Richards.

There were track wins for the men from Matthew Agnimel & Lewis Bailey (200m A & B), James Stewart (5000m A), and B string wins for Reece Malcolm (100m B), Louise Berrett (400m), and Charlie Burgess (800m PB). Luke Williams and Arron Bonning took full points in the pole vault, as did Peter Brinton-Quinn & Bobby Wiliams in the javelin, and Richard Holland in the B long jump, and the sprint relay quartet of Luke Williams, Matthew Agnimel, Maxwell Adeosun and Reece Malcolm brough the baton home safely to win.

There were 20 wins for the ladies' squad as they dominated events. Cassie Campbell improved her bests to win both 100m and 200m sprints as Precious Fagbadegun won the B string 100m. Ruby Tillson and Chloe Willaims took full points in A & B 100m hurdles, as did Chloe and Claire Brennan in the 400m hurdles, as Scarlett Woods joined Claire in the winning pole vault pairing.

There was almost a clean sweep in the field events as Katie Ennis won both hammer & discus, Lucy Quinlan improved her best to win the javelin, Eboni Roach & Tillson won the A & B shot in PBS, as Eboni added B hammer victory, and Tilly Bunn won the B discus. Further B string wins were earned by Under 17s Maggie Smith (high jump), Grace Tilson (triple jump PB) and Daisy Leech (long jump), all in their first taste of the competition in this senior league.

Not surprisingly both relay teams won as Chloe, Cassie, Maggie and Precious combined to win the sprint relay and Nina Brenna, Grace, Daisy and Chloe won the 4x400m relay event to round of a successful start to the season for the team.

The second round of the four-match series sees the squad travel to Peterborough on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June.
