Haverling's Under 17 and Under 20 squad finished a good second in their second round match at Ashton Playing Fields, Woodford on Saturday.

The **Under 17 Men's** squad led the way with ten wins. There were win doubles for the 800m pair of Sam Mahoney and Oscar Shearing, sprint hurdlers Al-Ameen Salaam and Archie Sims, who added a 400m hurdles victory too, and javelin duo Oliver Grundy and Matthew Page. Reece Malcolm won the 100m B race, while Wyatt Larkins had a B string win double in the shot and discus, as his A string partners Oscar Shearing and Michael Tesi both placed second. Teddy Matthews was second in the B long jump, as was Owen Fisher in the 1500m A, with Oliver Taylor-Bush third in the 1500m B. Archie Sims, Lewis Dixon, Waleed Kabuye and Oliver Taylor-Bush combined for third in the 4x400m relay.

Jacob Blanc smashed his personal best to win the **Under 20 Men's** 400m in the ninth fastest ever by a club U20, and Jacob's winning sprint hurdles times took him to fifth on the club U20 all-time list, as James With won the B hurdles event and Simon Hill won the javelin. Ronnie Adoma had a pair of runners up placings in the 100m & 200m, as did 1500m runner Shane Hart, and there were third places for Calvin Sanni (200m & 400m B), Charlie Howell (800m) and Under 17s Leon Bengo (high jump) and Matthew Page (shot). The squad's day ended on a high as Ronnie, Shane and Charlie were joined by Under 17 Oscar Shearing in the winning 4x400m relay quartet.

Steph Okoro was class apart as she stepped up to win the **Under 20 Women's** 400m in a new PB, the third fastest ever by a club U17, as Amy Kilner was second in both the B 400m and the triple jump. Hannah Yexley's season's best placed her second in the discus, and Olivia Boachie was second in the 200m and third in the 100m, with second places also earned by Maddie Barker's 800m PB, and Precious Fagbadegun in the 200m B race. Amy, Olivia, Maddie and Steph were runners up in the 4x400m relay, as Precious, Olivia, Eliza Poulson and Steph were third in the sprint relay

Discus throwers Tilly Bunn and Erin Delea took full points in the **Under 17 Women's** event, with Tilly second in the B shot. Emily Fessey Cook was second in the javelin, as was Abi Swan in the B string, after placing third in the 1500m. Paris King was runner up in both the 200m B and sprint hurdles, as Eliza Poulson was third in the hurdles B string to add to her triple jump third place. Zara Okocha (100m B), Cassie Campbell (200m A) and Natalie Pepper (300m hurdles) were also third. Cassie, Paris, Abi and Zara were second in the sprint relay.

Crawley took the win, to add to their first round second place, to lead the table at the half-way stage, as first round winners Tonbridge could only finish fourth but hold onto second in the standings ahead of Haverling.
